SECTION I

In addition, it lists structural changes of state chartered banks and savings institutions, such as opening and closing of offices and the effective date of mergers, acquisitions and relocations.

This bulletin constitutes **the only notice of such activities that you will receive** from the Bureau of Financial Institutions.
