## **MEMORANDUM**

TO:

All Companies Licensed to Sell Accident and Sickness Insurance, all

Prepaid Plans, and Life and Casualty Cooperative or Assessment Companies

RE:

Regulations 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22

Over the past few months, it has become apparent that a number of companies are not ye in compliance with Virginia's regulations concerning accident and sickness minimum standard rate filing, and readability. As a reminder, these regulations are:

Although these regulations contain staggered effective dates, all individual accident an sickness policies issued on and after July 1, 1982 must be in compliance both with readabilit requirements and with the applicable minimum standards regulation. Because of the significar new requirements of these regulations, this means that the forms must have been approved on cafter July 1, 1982 or specific reference must have been made in our approval letter prior to this date for the forms to comply.

It has come to our attention that a number of companies are continuing to issue form which do not meet the requirements of these regulations. In addition, rate filings continue to h submitted which do not provide the information required pursuant to Regulation No. 22.

Each recipient of this Administrative Letter is requested to examine its portfolio and immediately discontinue the sale of any policy or other form which either has not been refile pursuant to the minimum standards requirements, or has not been refiled or certified pursuant the readability requirements, or both. You are further requested to institute any and all interruptocedures necessary to verify that all individual accident and sickness rate filings are hencefor submitted in proper form. It is also suggested that you examine your accident and sickness replacement questic required under Regulations 19, 20, and 21 and that the required replacement notices are availab for use.
