

AMENDMENTS TO ADMINISTRATIVE LETTER 1983-5

TO: All Life and Accident and Sickness Insurance Companies Licensed in Virginia

RE: Implementation of House Bill 419 as it applies to Code Section 38.1-327.24 entitled "Certificate of qualification required of life and health insurance agents"

Please be advised that Administrative Letter 1983-5 dated June 1, 1983 has been amended due to the nonavailability of the "Agents Insurance Examination Preparation Manual" for Life and Health Insurance. These amendments are as follows:

- 1. The effective date for implementation has been changed from Monday, October 3, 1983 to Monday, January 2, 1984.
- 2. Each class operated by an approved school must have a minimum of <u>five</u> rather than <u>ten</u> students.
- 3. Instructors who are approved to teach the forty-five hour pre-licensing qualification course must meet the following criteria:
 - a) Submit a <u>current</u> and <u>detailed</u> resume for review by Bureau personnel;
 - b) Have a CLU, FLMI, Master of Insurance Degree or other equivalent insurance education satisfactory to the State Corporation Commission, or, a minimum of three years life and health insurance management or training experience; or
 - c) Be an insurance teacher at an approved educational institution.
