APPLICATION OF

VIRGINIA PROPERTY INSURANCE ASSOCIATION

For approval of forms for use in writing Basic Property insurance as defined in Section on 38.2-2701 of the Virginia Code on qualified property in the Commonwealth of Virginia

BY LETTERS DATED January 13, 2003, January 28, 2003, and February 24, 2003 on behalf of its member companies, the Virginia Property Insurance Association filed with and requested approval of the Commissioner of Insurance forms for use in writing Basic Property Insurance as defined in Section 38.2-2701 of the Virginia Code on qualified property.

AND IT APPEARING to the Commissioner that a hearing should not be held thereon, that there is no objection otherwise, and that the publication of notice of the filing is not necessary;

AND IT APPEARING to the Commissioner from an examination made by the staff of the Bureau of Insurance, that the following forms are proper and are not in conflict or inconsistent with the laws of the Commonwealth, and the approval of the application should be granted for new and renewal policies effective on and after February 25, 2003:

CL-0600 03 03 Certified Terrorism Loss

FP CL 0640 12 02 Non-Certified Act Of Terrorism Exclusion (With Limited Exception)

And War and Military Action Exclusion
