## NATIONAL COUNCIL ON COMPENSATION INSURANCE

ORDER WITHDRAWING THE PREVIOUS REVISIONS TO BASIC MANUAL CLASSIFICATIONS FOR THE AVIATION INDUSTRY UNDER NCCI ITEM FILING B-1399-VA.

BY LETTER DATED June 12, 2006, came National Council on Compensation Insurance on behalf of its members and requested the of approval of the Commissioner of Insurance to withdraw certain revisions to the Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rates for writing Workers' Compensation Insurance in this Commonwealth because the filing failed to give appropriate consideration to the excessive nature of rate increases that would apply to certain employers as a result of the filing, to wit:

Item B-1399-VA Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications for the Aviation Industry

AND IT APPEARING to the Commissioner that a hearing should not be held thereon, and the publication of notice of the filing is not necessary;

NOW, ON THIS DAY the Commissioner, having considered the filing herein, is of the opinion, finds and orders:

- (1) That Item B-1399-VA, previously approved by Administrative Order 11738 for use in this Commonwealth for policies effective on or after July 1, 2006, applicable to new and renewal business only, is hereby withdrawn, and previously approved classifications are reinstated,
- (2) THAT AN ATTESTED copy hereof shall be sent to the National Council on Compensation Insurance; to the Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission; and, to Mary M. Bannister, Deputy Commissioner of Insurance.
