December 3, 2008 and December 5, 2008, came National Council on Compensation Insurance on behalf of its members and filed with and requested the approval of the Commissioner of Insurance of certain revisions to the Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rates for writing Workers' Compensation Insurance in this Commonwealth, to wit:

- (1) That the proposed revisions to the Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rates for writing Workers' Compensation Insurance in this Commonwealth will not produce rates which are excessive, inadequate, or unfairly discriminatory, and should be, and they hereby are, approved for use in this Commonwealth for policies effective on or after April 1, 2010, applicable to new and renewal business only, and
