Audio Teleconferencing Calls can be heard through the audio system in the courtrooms.

Ideal for: Conferencing in parties physically unable to attend a meeting/hearing

Wireless Hearing Assistance Headsets for those hard of hearing.

Document Camera Updated version of the overhead projector. Display hard copies of documents, one page at a time,

Very easy to use.

Ideal for: Displaying a hard copy of a document (separate pages) or photos

DVD/VCR Video Player Displays visual content on DVDs, VHS tapes, and plays audio CDs.

PointMaker Graphic Pen & Pad. Electronically illustrate, draw, or highlight displayed content.

Video Printer Print a snapshot of any content displayed in current view. Use sparingly.

Laptop Connections View or listen to any content from a laptop. You must use your own personal laptop. SCC laptops

are for employee use only.

Ideal for: Viewing files (i.e., Word documents, PDFs, Excel spreadsheets, PowerPoint

presentations, Access documents, photos) saved on your laptop's hard drive, thumb drive, and

CD/DVD. Also used to play audio and video content.
