On August 1, 2002, the Commission forwarded the Report of Hearing Examiner Alexander F. Skirpan, Jr., to the FCC. On October 30, 2002, the FCC released its Memorandum Opinion and Order in WC Docket No. 02-214, which granted the application of Verizon Virginia Inc. to provide in-region, interLATA services in Virginia, effective November 8, 2002.
