## **OBSERVATION REPORT #41**

KPMG Consulting observed that Verizon's Product Interval Guides do not provide provisioning intervals for UNE-Platform line splitting orders.

## **Issue**

According to Verizon Change Request #2055, the committed date for line splitting in the Northeast and Southeast regions is October 20, 2001. However, neither the *UNE-P Standard Intervals*<sup>1</sup> nor the *Intervals for Unbundled Network Elements*<sup>2</sup> documents found on the Verizon East Customer Support website provides the intervals necessary for ordering Verizon's line splitting product.

## **Assessment**

CLECs rely on complete documentation to correctly prepare orders. Incomplete provisioning intervals inhibit a CLEC's ability to inform its customers when line splitting services will be provisioned.
