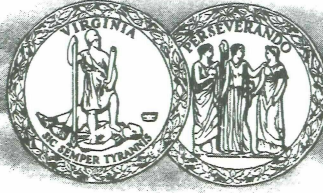

Dear Mr. Spencer:

This is in reference to Verizon South Inc.'s tariff filing received on January 14, 2010 pursuant to the administrative process authorized by the Commission's December 14, 2007 order in Case No. PUC-2007-00008. The Division of Communications has determined that the competitiveness test criteria set out in this order have been met for residential BLETS individual line service in the Bridgewater, Crittenden, Dayton, Doswell, Dulles, Elkton, Keezletown, and McGaheysville exchanges.

In addition, we have taken no action on residential BLETS individual line service in the Callao, Chuckatuck, Grottoes, Holland, Pamplin, Port Royal, Raphine, and Windsor exchanges as Verizon has agreed to withdraw those proposed tariffs and has advised the Staff that it is no longer seeking competitive determination in those exchanges at this time.

Accordingly, Verizon needs to resubmit tariff pages to reflect the competitive status of the eight exchanges meeting the test as discussed above.
