HEARING EXAMINER'S RULING

August 15, 2002

On July 12, 2002, Verizon Virginia Inc. ("Verizon") filed a Motion to Correct Transcript as set forth in the attachment thereto. On July 15, 2002, a Hearing Examiner's Ruling provided the parties with an opportunity to file any objections to the suggested transcript changes. No objections were filed.

The Commission's Rules provide that "[b]y agreement of the parties, or as the commission may by order provide, corrections may be made to the transcript."¹ Because no party has objected to Verizon's proposed changes to the transcript, I find that these changes should be made. Accordingly,
